

Report on Myanmar Grace School (2024.09)

Since 2022, Myanmar Grace School has been supported by CCIUSA. There are over 90 students, including orphans, children from single-parent families, and those with both parents. Most of them come from mountainous areas, and the environment has greatly improved since the school moved to a new location. Some caring individuals have visited the school to meet the children and brought them daily necessities.



Older students have been able to attend Bible training classes and "Kairos" courses. They return to lead Bible studies for younger students, hoping that the flame of revival through the Lord Jesus Christ will manifest in the lives of these children.



Last month, the youngest girl fell ill and went to the hospital, where she was diagnosed with a severe colon ulcer that required surgery. The school covered the 2,000 RMB needed for the surgery performed that evening. The girl has since fully recovered and is now living a normal life.

School staff have also led students to remote mountain villages where the gospel has not been heard, sharing the good news with the villagers.

One student, from a mountain area and a struggling family, has four siblings, all of whom currently attend the school. Three of them have been baptized.

- Pray for the ongoing conflict in Muse, asking God to bring peace to this land. Currently, one of Myanmar's armed forces, the Alliance Army, is negotiating with the Myanmar military. Pray for wisdom and discernment for the leaders to resolve the conflict.
- Pray for the school staff's permit to re-enter Myanmar. Due to legal restrictions over the past year, they have been stuck in Ruili, Yunnan, unable to return to school. Pray that God will open a way for them to return soon.
